Summary

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56133, Commission approval is required for agreements between local agencies and landowners for provision of service outside of the agency's boundaries. This provision requires that the public agency apply by resolution on behalf of the landowner for LAFCo approval before it can extend service to the property. In this case, the City of South San Francisco has applied for extension of sewer service to a parcel located at 288 Alta Vista in unincorporated County Club Park. Commission approval is recommended.

Environmental Health:

The California Water Service Company and the City of South San Francisco provide the available water and sewer service in the area. The parcel cannot pass soil percolation test for an on-site sewage disposal system.

Recommendation:

San Mateo County Planning:

There is a pending building permit application to allow construction of a single-family home. The issuance of the building permit is contingent on sewer approval as percolation tests have failed. Land use designation is low density residential with 2.2 units per acre. General Plan LAFCo File 00-12 January 9, 2001 Page 2

Policy 11.5 favors consideration of sewerage systems as the appropriate method of wastewater disposal in urban areas.

Recommendation: Approve

Staff Report and Recommendation:

This proposal has been submitted by resolution of the City of South San Francisco following the property owner's request to extend sewer service to 288 Alta Vista Drive, a 0.9 acre parcel. The landowners have applied to the San Mateo County Planning Division to demolish an existing residence and construct a single-family residence. Sewer service approval is a condition of approval of the permit because the parcel has failed to pass a percolation test for on-site septic. The parcel is not contiguous to city boundaries and therefore not currently eligible for annexation to the City. The proposal is, however, consistent with the City's policy of providing sewer service to the unincorporated County Club Park neighborhood.

The project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) because it involves sewer extension of reasonable length to serve Class 3 construction (one single-family residence) [15303(d)].

The subject area is within the sphere of influence of the City of South San Francisco adopted by the Commission in 1976. The City currently provides sewer service to several other properties in the unincorporated area, including two adjacent parcels.

As stated in draft policies for review of service agreements outside jurisdictional boundaries, LAFCo can not set conditions that directly regulate land use, development or subdivision requirements. The Commission can however, encourage local agencies to consult on projects to be developed in unincorporated areas. It is recommended that in this case, transmittal of approval of extension of sewer service include a recommendation that the City of South San Francisco and the County of San Mateo consult in reviewing the project.

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<u>Recommendation</u>: The proposal is consistent with the City's sphere of influence and with service already extended to the area by the City of South San Francisco. It is therefore respectfully recommended that the Commission approve the proposed agreement for extension of service.

Recommended Commission Action, by motion:

1. Approve LAFCo File No. 00-12- Proposed Outside Service Agreement between the City of South San Francisco and Peters and direct staff to transmit a letter of approval to the City and the property owner, including a recommendation that the City of South San Francisco and the County of San Mateo Planning Division consult on review of the project.


