Water Service to 720 Paradise Way, Unincorporated San Mateo County

Summary

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56133, Commission approval is required for extension of service by local agencies to territory outside the agency's boundaries. This section requires that the public agency apply to LAFCo by resolution on behalf of the landowner. In this case, the City of Redwood City has applied for extension of water and sewer service to a proposed subdivision on Edgewood Road. Water and sewer connections are County of San Mateo conditions of approval for the subdivision. The project area is within the sphere of influence of the City of Redwood City and the City's water service area. Commission approval is recommended.

Staff Report and Recommendation:

This proposal was submitted by resolution of the City of Redwood City as a condition of approval of the San Mateo County Planning Commission for a minor subdivision. The subject area is within the sphere of influence of the City of Redwood City and the City's water service area but is not eligible for annexation because it is not contiguous to the city boundary. Sam Mateo County Environmental Health reports that the City of Redwood City provides the available water and the County San Mateo Emerald Lake Sewer Maintenance District provides sewer service in the area and the proposal has no adverse environmental health significance. There are three registered voters in the subject territory.

The proposal is consistent with the City's sphere of influence and with water service already extended to the area by the City of Redwood City as well as existing Commission policies that allow service extension when annexation is not feasible. Recent consideration by the Commission of similar applications has included discussion of policies that would provide for property owner agreement to subsequent annexation when properties become eligible. The City of Redwood City General Plan does not contain such policies. LAFCo staff is reviewing existing Commission policy regarding Section 56133 with regard to potential language to address this issue and recommends that once

drafted, recommended policies amendments be circulated to Cities and the County of San Mateo Planning Department for comment prior to Commission consideration. Staff will have the opportunity to comment on the City's upcoming General Plan update.

In the meantime, it is respectfully recommended that the Commission, by motion, approve this proposed request for extension of service and authorize the Executive Officer to send a letter of approval to the City and the property owner.
